STEP 1	We admitted we were powerless over alcohol - that our lives had become unmanageable	I admit that I am powerless against sin and without HIM my life would be completely chaotic
STEP 2	Came to believe that a power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.	I know that in HIM is where I live, move and have my being. Without HIM there is no me
STEP 3	Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him	I not only accept HIM as my SAVIOUR I'm learning to make HIM LORD over EVERY aspect of my life
STEP 4	Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves	I'm constantly asking HIM to create in me a clean and renew the right spirit in me
STEP 5	Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs	I acknowledge, admit and repent
STEP 6	Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character	I know I can't change myself and I rely solely on HIM for REAL and everlasting change
STEP 7	Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings	I know where I'm weak HE is strong
STEP 8	Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.	I know that strengthening my relationship with HIM makes it possible for me to repair and nurture the right relationships
STEP 9	Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others	I ask for discernment and pray for strength to obey
STEP 10	Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.	I continually examine my thoughts and ways against HIS Word and in my wrong I quickly admit and repent
STEP 11	Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God, as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out	I pray for wisdom, guidance, strength to accept HIS will and obey HIS commands
STEP 12	Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these Steps, we tried to carry this message to alcoholics, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.	As a born-again Christian, I strive to be a witness for Christ with a mission to draw someone to HIM
